*Students tour an operational greenhouse and learn how it works!

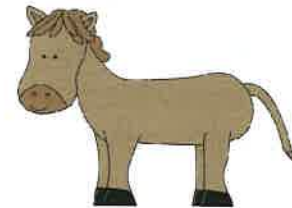
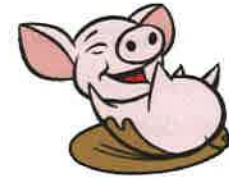
*All exhibits are designed and presented by FFA members—this is truly a student led and student centered program!

What's it About?



Each year the members of the Phillipsburg FFA Chapter organize and host an annual Barnyard Days program.

During this FREE two day event, students enrolled in agricultural classes advocate to youth on the importance of agriculture through well-known farm animals and equipment. Each year we provide a fun and educational tour of 12-14 agricultural exhibits. At each exhibit FFA members will give a three minute presentation explaining their topic and answer children's questions.

The educational tour usually lasts approximately an hour and fifteen minutes. At the conclusion of the tours, the Phillipsburg FFA provides visiting students with a snack consisting of ice cream and popcorn, and, if needed, apples as an alternative snack.

Barnyard Day's is open to children up to Third grade. We typically have close to 2,000 people visit our program each year. We hope your group will want to join us this year!

Exhibits

Agriculture plays a crucial role in our everyday lives and this role continues to increase daily. Phillipsburg FFA members will educate youth on the importance of agriculture through presentations that include the proper care of livestock and the benefits each animal provides for humans.
