Dear Parents/Guardians of 5th and 6th graders:

Your child is invited to participate in this year's 5-6 Battle of the Books competition. Participants form teams of 3-5 students that will share the responsibility of reading 15 books from a selected list. Teams then compete in a trivia contest against other schools in Hunterdon County. Each team will compete in three rounds of questions based on the books they have read. The date of the competition is still to be determined, but will most likely happen sometime in April at Holland Township School. This is an afterschool event and students will need to arrange their own transportation.

Most of the preparation required for this event will consist of independent reading of books from the approved list. The books can be obtained through the school and public libraries. We will try to hold brief meetings during the school day to keep tabs on team progress completing the list and to prepare for the competition. It is vital that your child understands the commitment they are making when they sign up for Battle of the Books. Their team is depending on them to read and attend meetings to insure success at the competition.
