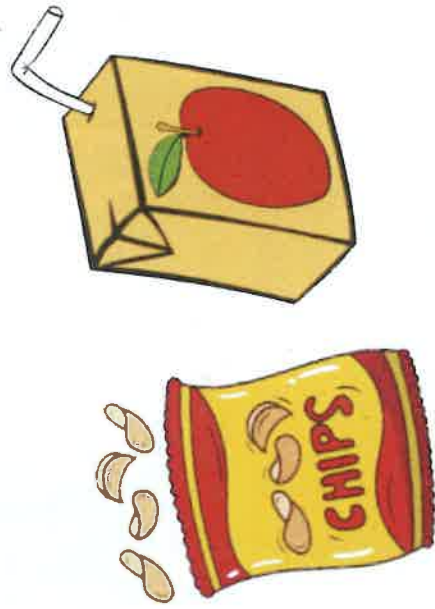


# WHY SHOULD YOU ATTEND?

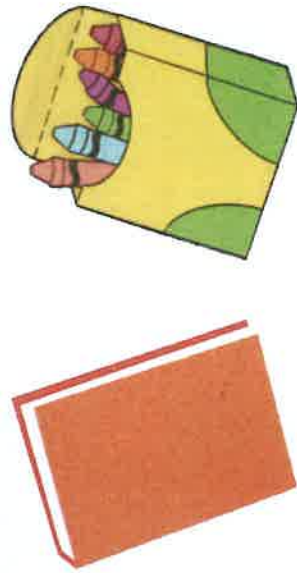
- Live animals are on display for students to view. They 'neigh', they 'cluck', and they 'moo'!

# WHAT'S IT ABOUT?

Each year members of the Phillipsburg FFA Chapter organize and hold an annual Barnyard Days program.

During this FREE two-day event, students enrolled in agricultural classes advocate to youth the importance of agriculture through well-known farm animals and equipment. Each year we provide a fun and educational tour of 12-14 agricultural exhibits. At each exhibit, FFA members will give a three-minute presentation explaining their topic and answer children's questions.

The educational tour usually lasts approximately an hour and fifteen minutes.
