

#### Holland Township School District Budget Development Process



- 1. **September- November 2021:** District staff collaboratively determine needs for the 2022-23 budget
- 2. **January-February:** Superintendent and Administrative staff reviews budget requests for reasonableness of needs within district resources. Staff and student enrollment projections reviewed.
- **3.** March: Proposed budget presented the BOE committee of the whole in two sessions.
- **4. March 10th:** State aid notices released to school districts
- 5. March 22nd: Proposed budget presented to the BOE @ regular meeting-further discussion regarding line items finalized
- **6. March 28th:** District submits the budget to the Executive County Superintendent for approval.
- 7. April 22nd: Advertised budget and notice of public hearing in the newspaper & district website
- **8. April 26th:** Public hearing and Board of Education adoption of the 2022-23 budget



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# Overall Budget Goal



To provide the best possible educational program for the children of the Holland Township School District while exercising the utmost diligence in the expenditure of public funds.

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- Budget Points

  Maintains all existing programs

  Utilizes grant funding to minimize impact of local tax dollars on total budget
  - Strengthens staff to provide remedial support through RTI
     (basic skills/enrichment) programming
     Increases programs for mental health and social emotional
    - - Develops additional Special Education programming
         Stays within the allowable 2% allowable tax cap

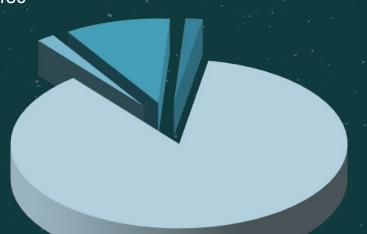

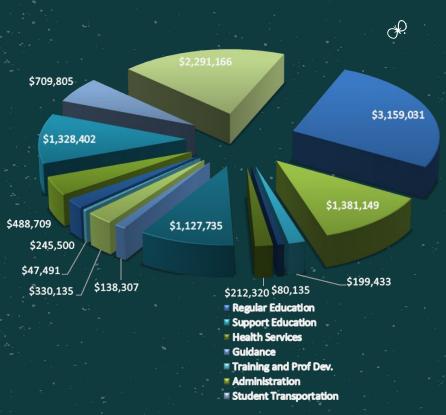

  - Provide professional development to support Tier II and III interventions







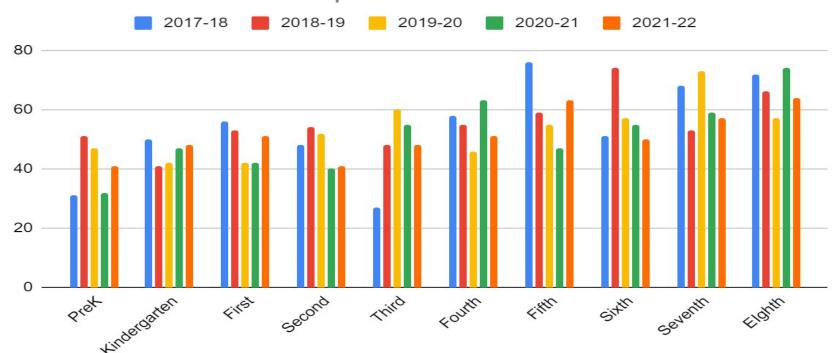

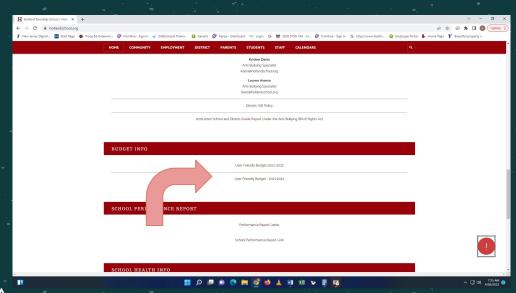


# Facility Improvements
