Dear Parents and Guardians:

Due to staffing and substitute shortages, the district will pivot to remote instruction for all students effective Thursday, January 6th, 2022 through Monday, January 10th, 2022. All afternoon, evening, and weekend activities are canceled. In person instruction is expected to resume on a full day schedule on Tuesday, January 11th, 2022.

All students will be sent home today with required technology and materials needed for the remote period. If your child was absent from school today, materials will be made available in the containers located in the Preschool vestibule at door #20.

We will follow a similar schedule as last year during the time the entire district was remote. Teachers will post specific schedules, Zoom links, and classwork on Google Classroom. Please contact your child's teacher if you have specific questions/concerns. Classroom instruction will occur as follows:
