E. School Ethics Commission Resolution of Suspension I/M/O Matthew Walker

Whereas, Matthew Walker (Respondent) is a school official, as defined in the School Ethics Act (Act), serving as a member of the Township of Holland Board of Education (Board), located in Hunterdon County, at all times relevant to the matter at issue in the above-captioned matter; and

Whereas, by amended decision dated June 28, 2022, the School Ethics Commission (Commission) found that Respondent failed to comply with the annual training mandate (deadline was December 31, 2021) in violation of N.J.S.A. 18A:12-33 and N.J.A.C. 6A:28-4.1; and

Whereas, the Commission recommended that the Commissioner of Education impose a penalty of removal, with such removal to become effective immediately upon adoption by the Commissioner of Education. However, if Respondent completed training before the Commissioner of Education adopted a final decision (which was forty-five (45) days after the Commission's decision was mailed), then the Commission recommended that the Commissioner of Education, in lieu of removal, impose a thirty (30) day suspension, with such suspension to become effective immediately upon adoption by the Commissioner of Education; and

Whereas, following issuance of the Commission's June 28, 2022, amended decision, Respondent completed mandated training; and

Whereas, by decision dated August 12, 2022, the Commissioner of Education found that Respondent failed to timely honor an obligation placed upon board of education members by law, concurred with the penalty recommended by the Commission, and ordered a thirty (30) day suspension from the Board; and

Whereas, N.J.A.C. 6A:28-10.12(d) provides that, for a penalty of censure, suspension or



removal, a Resolution shall be adopted at the Commission's next meeting following issuance of the Commissioner's decision, and the Resolution shall be read at the next public meeting of the Board following its adoption, and shall be posted in such places as the Board posts its public notices for a period of no less than thirty (30) days; and Now Therefore Be It Resolved that the Commission adopts this Resolution stating that Respondent is hereby SUSPENDED FOR THIRTY DAYS (from August 12, 2022, through September 11, 2022) for having been found to have violated N.J.S.A. 18A:12-33 of the Act, and its implementing regulation, namely N.J.A.C. 6A:28-4.1; and

Be It Further Resolved that the Board is ordered to read this Resolution at its next regularly scheduled public meeting, and to post it in such places as the Board posts its public notices for a period of no less than thirty (30) days.

Be It Further Resolved, that the Board shall provide the Commission with the minutes, once adopted, from the meeting at which it reads the within Resolution.
